Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. is a private, non-profit organization whose purpose is to provide assistance and support through established programs in local communities throughout the world. A sisterhood of more than 200,000 predominately Black college educated women, the Sorority currently has over 900 chapters located in the United States, England, Japan (Tokyo and Okinawa), Germany, the Virgin Islands, Bermuda, the Bahamas and the Republic of Korea. **The major programs of the sorority are based upon the organization's Five Point Thrust of:**

- **Economic Development**
- **Educational Development**
- **International Awareness and Involvement**
- **Physical and Mental Health**
- **Political Awareness and Involvement**

In 1973 the Sorority established its National Commission on Arts & Letters. The ultimate goal of the Commission is to boldly advance the Black Experience through arts and letters and to promote the contributions of African-Americans in the arts—past and present. Moreover, the Commission is charged with preserving, supporting, communicating and projecting all art forms that express the Black Experience through artistic expression, as it relates to promoting the creative works of African-American artists, particularly those of women.

On January 3, 2010 IAC's Arts and Letters Committee is organizing a group outing to see the award winning production, **"The Color Purple"**, produced by Oprah Winfrey. A portion of the proceeds will benefit two of IAC's premiere youth programs, the Delta GEMS and Dr. Betty Shabazz Delta Academy.



The Delta GEMS (Growing & Empowering Myself Successfully) is a national initiative that serves girls in grades 9-12. These young ladies participate in cultural activities, development workshops, and service projects led by Sorors who serve as facilitators. The goals of the program are: to instill the need to excel academically; to provide tools that enable girls to sharpen and enhance their skills to achieve high levels of academic success; to assist girls in proper goal setting and planning for their futures high school and beyond; and to create compassionate, caring, and community minded young women by actively

involving them in service learning and community service opportunities. The program boasts over 60 participants during the 2009 - 2010 year.

The Dr. Betty Shabazz Delta Academy is a national initiative that serves girls age 11-14. The Delta Academy provides enriching & educational activities, in a mentoring setting to girls at a crucial time in their development. A primary goal of the Delta Academy program is to prepare young girls for full participation as leaders in the 21st Century. Past workshop topics include: Netiquette (internet etiquette), self image, peer pressure, and college preparedness. The girls in the program also participate in public service & attend cultural events.
